

Manufacturing Technician

Job Duties:

The manufacturing technician will be responsible for performing mechanical assembly as part of pilot-scale manufacturing of disposable medical devices. The candidate will be directly responsible for operating and maintaining chemical, automation, and assembly equipment. Job duties may also include shipping & receiving, quality control inspections, and inventory control. Expectations:
